1. Build a complete AI register

Build a classified register of every AI use case across the business, categorised against the EU AI Act risk framework and linked to the models and providers behind them. When a regulator asks, you have a structured answer and evidence ready.



2. Prioritise your AI risks

Evaluate your AI register to understand where risk actually lives. Screen broadly, then go deeper where it counts, considering prohibited use, human impact, data handling and privacy. Build a documented picture of your risk and then act against it.



3. Manage AI incidents and misuse

When AI misuse or data leakage occurs, the response must be fast, consistent and documented. Record every incident, track it to resolution and demonstrate a repeatable, traceable process when it matters most.



4. Govern AI inside your existing programme

Link your AI model providers and use cases to your existing vendor, control and risk programmes. Inform decisions about renewing vendor relationships, building new IT controls, or policies. AI governance that works within your broader GRC programme, not alongside it.



5. Scaled by Gracie AI

AI has not arrived through a single strategy. **Operational benefits**

It has spread team by team, tool by tool, not always through formal approval or a clear line of accountability. Risk and compliance teams have inherited the consequences: model behaviour failures, data handling risks, operational disruption and expanding autonomy boundaries, with limited visibility across any of it.

The external pressure is real. The EU AI Act places enforceable legal obligations on organisations operating AI systems in the EU, with full enforcement from August 2026. ISO 42001 and the NIST AI RMF are fast becoming the benchmarks boards, auditors and customers will use to judge whether your governance is credible.

The gap between what boards expect, what AI risks are present and what most teams can evidence is growing. Tracking on spreadsheets is not enough.

- **Avoid costly fines for non-compliance.** Risk classification is built into your process, so you can categorise every AI use case against EU AI Act requirements from the start and avoid fines up to 35m euros or 7% of your turnover.
- **Separate the sanctioned AI from the shadow.** Organisations don't know the full extent of their AI use. SureCloud gives you the method to find it, manage it and reduce the potential for expensive exposure.
- **Evidence that stands up to scrutiny.** Every assessment, incident and model provider is recorded and has supporting context. When a regulator or auditor asks for proof, you have what you need, ready to send with a 75% reduction in manual audit prep.
